PURPOSE:

The Water Resources Department is requesting city council authorize an interconnection agreement between the City of Greensboro and Duke Energy Carolinas for backup power generator interconnections at the Mitchell Water Treatment Plant.

BACKGROUND:

The Mitchell Water Treatment Plant is nearing completion of electrical upgrades to support the site. The electrical upgrades include a backup generator and automatic transfer switches that provide electric power redundancy for the operation of the plant. To provide automatic switchover during a power failure event, the city of Greensboro will be required to interconnect with Duke Energy. The interconnectivity and switchover process requires momentary paralleling of electrical sources to ensure no disruption of service or plant operation. Duke Energy Carolinas requires the execution of a utility interconnection agreement to allow for the momentary paralleling of sources https://www.greensboro-nc.gov/home/showdocument?id=51321&t=637749849060864164.
