PURPOSE:

The purpose of this agenda item is to approve a 7 year contract renewal in the amount of \$1,110,000.00 with Greensboro Sports Foundation. Greensboro's sports tourism efforts create economic development that benefits Greensboro.

BACKGROUND:

Greensboro Sports Foundation was formed to provide entertainment, hosting and other general assistance in connection with hosting various events, including the Atlantic Coast Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments, NCAA Basketball, Atlantic Coast Conference and NCAA events at the Greensboro Aquatic Center and other events as mutually agreed upon to be held at the Greensboro Coliseum Complex. The contract was last renewed in 2015 and is up for renewal this year.
