PURPOSE:

Field Operations is requesting City Council to adopt the budget ordinance to amend the Solid Waste Capital Reserve fund and the Solid Waste Capital Improvements fund for the appropriation of funds for the partial closure of the White Street Landfill Phase III project.

BACKGROUND: The Solid Waste Capital Reserve Fund and the Solid Waste Capital Improvements Fund are used to establish funding necessary for solid waste capital projects. The partial closure of Phase III (cells I and II) of the White Street Landfill is underway and funds are necessary for the construction project to take place. A budget ordinance needs to be approved by City Council to establish this budget.
