SUBJECT: M/WBE Memo for Contract 2020-5078 - System-Wide Collection and

Rainfall Monitoring Services, Change Order 1

The M/WBE Office reviewed the change order request for contract 2020-5078 - System-wide Collection and Monitoring Services to determine continued compliance with the City's M/WBE Program Plan. The contractor is required to maintain the M/WBE participation for the duration of the contract unless approved in advance by the City. The Water Resources Department's request is for additional services, such as replacement, relocation, and repair of equipment and/or field services.

ADS Environmental Services was awarded a contract that was approved by the Council on February 18, 2020, in the amount of \$746,915.10 with a WBE 9.08% utilization. Change Order #1 for \$28,000.00 will increase the contract value to \$774,915.10 and the firm has committed to utilizing 9.08% (\$2,542.40) of the change order amount to an WBE. The overall contract utilization will remain the same WBE 9.08% (\$70,342.40). The contract continues to comply with the requirements of the M/WBE Program Plan. ADS Environmental Services will utilize the following WBE firm.
