**PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests council approval to amend bond funding for the Water Resources Capital Project Revenue Bond Fund budget for Construction of the Camp Burton Sewer Construction Project. Council approval is required for the budget ordinance permitting the expenditure of funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

The city intends to provide water and sewer service to the Camp Burton site to facilitate development of a new Army Reserve Center. This project will include a pump station adequately sized to eliminate four upstream pump stations, (Corbin Rd, McKnight Mill, Brightwood, and Nealtown Rd Lift Station). This project will increase the city's service area by 2,100 acres. The associated force main will be 24" and generally follow Camp Burton Road connecting to the Rock Creek Force Main. The Outfall to the pump station is approximately 21,000 linear feet of sewer line ranging from 8-inches to 36-inches in size.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Bond Fund budget by \$11,849,329 from revenue bond funding.
