PURPOSE:

As a condition of receiving federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grants funds, the City of Greensboro must submit an Annual Action Plan on behalf of Greensboro and HOME Program Consortium member jurisdictions Burlington, Guilford, and Alamance counties. The Annual Action Plan is due to HUD by August 16, 2022 after City Council approval.

BACKGROUND:

The Annual Action Plan describes how the City and HOME Consortium partners plan to meet ongoing commitments and mandates using the anticipated FY 2022-2023 awards.

CDBG Funding for the City of Greensboro (\$2,524,935)

\$2,374,935 HUD funds; \$150,000 estimated program income

Proposed Uses of CDBG Funds:

Program Administration: \$624,987

Fair Housing Activities: \$18,500

Citywide Housing Rehabilitation: \$711,448

Neighborhood Reinvestment: \$200,000

Infrastructure Redevelopment: \$300,000

Emergency Shelter: \$200,000

Contingency Activity: \$100,000

Homelessness Prevention: \$120,000

BUDGET IMPACT:

\$2,374,935 in new federal HUD grant funds and an estimated \$150,000 in program income will be available to address affordable housing, economic development, and community revitalization needs in Greensboro.
