#### **PURPOSE**:

In an effort to process Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) applications quickly, the Greensboro Housing Coalition (GHC) has partnered with the City to issue payments for all City reviewed and approved ERAP applications. Administration funds will be used to support staff time dedicated to reviewing and approving applications for payment.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Beginning December 2021, City staff started finalizing all ERAP applications previously processed by the Salvation Army of Greensboro. GHC has agreed to process payments for all applications that City staff reviewed and approved. GHC has the ability to process checks quickly and efficiently, which assists with the expedition of payment for tenants in need of rental and utility assistance.
