**PURPOSE:**

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests approval to amend bond funding for the Water Resources Capital Project Revenue Bond Fund budget for Construction Administration Services for the Sandy Creek Sewer Lift Station Sewer Construction Project. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

**BACKGROUND:**

This project will include installing a new regional wastewater pump station on Starmount Road in Liberty, NC. The new pump station consists of a 1.8 million gallon per day wastewater pump and a concrete wet well structure, as well as all related site work and appurtenances.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Bond Fund budget by \$615,000 from revenue bond funding.
