PURPOSE:

City Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to appropriate funds for the Emergency Rental Assistance program in the amount of \$843,936.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Greensboro received returned funds from The Salvation Army from a contract for Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA1 and ERA2) programs. The amount of the returned funds is \$843,936.33. A separate Council action will authorize an increased contract award to the Greensboro Housing Coalition from these fund sources to carry out program activities.

\$391,936 Emergency Rental Assistance Program 1 and \$452,000 Emergency Rental Assistance Program 2.
