PURPOSE:

City Council is requested to consider amending an interlocal agreement with Guilford County for a reduction in Emergency Rental Assistance program funds.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Greensboro ("City") entered into an inter-local agreement (Memorandum of Understanding) with Guilford County ("County") on November 12, 2021 for up to \$10,000,000 in Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) program funds to continue a financial assistance program for eligible tenant households. The County wishes to reduce Parent Contract No. 90003695 by \$3,500,000, and agrees to pay the City a sum of money up to \$6,500,000 from its available ERA funds to be used exclusively for Rental and Utilities Assistance. In order to facilitate the disbursement of ERA program funds to applicants, the County will be processing a portion of the remaining ERA program applications.

BUDGET IMPACT:

A reduction in the amount of \$3,500,000 in Emergency Rental Assistance Program funds from Guilford County.

It is recommended that City Council authorize amending an interlocal agreement (Memorandum of Understanding) with Guilford County for up to \$6,500,000 in Emergency Rental Assistance program funds to continue a financial assistance program for eligible tenant households and to authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement documents.
