**PURPOSE:**

The Greensboro Police Department has been awarded two Homeland Security Grants from North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) totaling \$86,000. A budget ordinance is needed to accept the awards.

**BACKGROUND:**

The North Carolina Emergency Management (NCEM) has awarded the Greensboro Police Department \$86,000 through the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP). They are two three-year grants that will become effective upon the execution of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the agencies. The first grant is \$36,000 to purchase a portable barricade system project. The vehicle barriers will allow officers to secure areas from on-coming traffic. Such areas would include outdoor public events, areas requiring a robust, secure perimeter or areas stricken by natural disasters. The second grant is \$50,000 to purchase an X-Ray system which will be used for hazardous device response, investigation, and mitigation. The

X-Ray system will be used by the GPD Hazardous Device team which is responsible for responding across a multi-county response area.
