PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department requests approval to amend bond funding for the Water Resources Capital Project Revenue Bond Fund budget for design of replacement Influent Pumps at T.Z. Osborne Wastewater Treatment Facility. Council approval is requested for a budget ordinance to permit the expenditure of funds.

BACKGROUND:

There are four influent pumps at the T.Z. Osborne Wastewater Reclamation Facility which are electrically inefficient and have exceeded their expected service life. These pumps are rated for approximately 28 million gallons per day (MGD) each. The influent pumps are located at the headworks of the plant and supply the treatment train. Failure of the pumps may result in an inability to treat wastewater and in turn a release of untreated wastewater. A significant release could result in a State issued fine.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This amendment will increase the Water Resources Bond Fund budget by \$425,000 from revenue bond funding.
