PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department is requesting approval to apply for funding with the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality to help fund infrastructure improvement projects.

BACKGROUND:

The State of North Carolina provides the opportunity for local governments to apply for grants and low interest loans for wastewater collection system, stormwater system and drinking water distribution projects. The Water Resources Department requests permission to apply for funding for the following proposed projects: the Fairview Street Stormwater Control Measure Retrofit; Cottage-Woodcroft-Webster Streambank Repair, Watershed Master Planning Study, and the Camp Burton Sewer Outfall. The proposed projects work to maintain and improve infrastructure and natural channel systems. Water Resources Department will be working on the grant

applications and evaluating scoring criteria for each of these proposed projects to put forth project applications that have a higher likelihood to be accepted by the State. In order to meet the grant application deadline of September 30, 2022, Water Resources is requesting the approval to apply. Water Resources currently has these projects within our planned Capital Improvements Program.
