PURPOSE:

The Water Resources Department is requesting approval of an on-call professional services contract for sanitary sewer system assessment support services. City Council approval of a contract with Hydrostructures, P.A. in the amount of \$ 350,000 is requested.

BACKGROUND:

Hydrostructures, P.A., a current design services on-call consultant, has expertise in field inspections of sanitary sewer collection systems and sewer collection asset management. These services are used to help eliminate rainfall-derived infiltration and inflow (I&I) into the city's sanitary sewer collection system. The data and findings are also used to help identify future projects aimed at rehabilitating and repairing aging sewer infrastructure.

Hydrostructures, P.A. provides these sanitary sewer assessment services for a variety of clients and has successfully done the same for the Water Resources Department. For this contract, the

project team will consist of Hydrostructures, P.A., J.C. Waller & Associates, P.C., a MBE, with contract utilizations of 5%; and Manholes and Pipeline Consulting, LLC, a WBE, with contract utilizations of 3%. The total M/WBE participation for this contract is 8%.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funding in the amount of \$350,000 is budgeted in the Water Resources Operating Fund.
