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#### **PURPOSE**:

To extend the existing agreement between the City of Greensboro and Vines Architecture/EVOKE Studio, in the amount of \$6,494,965, for completion of design development, construction documents, and construction administration for the Windsor Chavis Nocho Community Complex project.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In 2016, residents approved a bond referendum which included funding for the planning of a joint facility to combine Windsor Community Recreation Center and the Vance Chavis Branch Library. On May 21, 2019, City Council approved a professional services contract in the amount of \$1,259,500 between the City of Greensboro and Vines Architecture, Inc./EVOKE Studio for the development of the project's conceptual and 50% schematic design. On August 18, 2021, City Council approved contract amendment #1 for \$667,300 for completion of the schematic

design at 100%. On February 8, 2022, the City completed amendment #2 to extend the contract timeline in order to complete project marketing materials. A third amendment will increase the contract value by \$6,494,965 in order to complete design development, construction documents and construction administration through project close out.

On August 16, 2022, City Council allocated \$8,000,000 of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to support the requested contract extension. A portion of these funds will also be allocated toward the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) delivery method with a proposal being accepted through August 31, 2022, and initial reviews to be completed in September 2022.

The MWBE office did not set goals for the professional services contract; however, prospective respondents were required to solicit and use certified M/WBEs if they were potential sources for services necessary to fulfill the contract. Respondents to the RFQ received additional evaluations points based on MBE/WBE participation. Vines Architecture, Inc./Evoke Studios are minority and minority-woman owned firms that will lead the project, along with a commitment of 39.74% MBE subcontractor participation utilization to include Evoke Studio Architecture, PLLC (MBE 34.29%), JC Waller & Associates (MBE 1.86%), Glimmer & Glow, LLC (MBE 1.43%) and Surface 678, PA (2.16%).

### RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

It is recommended that City Council approve the amendment of the professional services contract with Vines Architecture, Inc./EVOKE Studio in the amount of \$6,494,965 for a total contract amount of \$8,421,765 for the completion of design development, construction documents and construction administration through project close out for the Windsor Chavis Nocho Community Complex.
