## **Operational Overview**

- Original facility constructed in 1963
- 2007 expansion for heavy duty equipment and tire shop
- 2,000+ pieces of equipment maintained
- Averaging 20 new equipment additions per year
- Implementing police take home vehicle policy
  - First 20 cars expected in January of 2023
  - Second order of 20 cars expected in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2023

## **Operational Challenges**

- Service bays at 100% capacity
- Space and facilities to accommodate current and future growth
- Facility, tools, and equipment modernization
- Warehouse consolidation
- Equipment parking at capacity
- Climate control

## **Progress to Date**

### **Preliminary Concept Contracts approved by Council on 3/15/22**

    - Facility requirements, capacity, layout, growth, grading, elevation, etc.
    - Conceptual drawings
  - MWBE Participation
    - 6.83% MBE
    - 15.11% WBE
      - Westcott Small WBE civil
      - Falcon Engineering WBE geotechnical
      - Bree Associates MBE cost estimating
  - Project is ready for next phase

- Samet Corporation \$260,000
- CMAR Pre-construction Services
  - Provide consultation to architects for design and constructability
  - Construction design
- MWBE Participation
  - 10% MBE Mentor Protégé
  - Junior Mentor Protégé

## **Proposed Next Steps**

#### Request City Council approval to contract with CPL Architecture for final design services:

- Schematic Design
- Design Development
- Construction Documents and Procurement
- Construction Administration over 18 Months

#### Final Design Contract value: \$2,270,500

■ 10% combined M/WBE participation proposed using same firms as preliminary work

# October 18, 2022 Meeting Request City Council action on 2 items:

- To approve contract with CPL Architecture to complete project design
- To approve ordinance that gives permission to fund contract with reimbursement from Limited Obligation Bonds planned for next spring

## **Project Financing Overview**

CMAR preliminary concept cost for "total" project is \$30 million

CMAR recommends single phase approach to streamline bidding and save approx. \$3.5 million

#### **Revised financing plan**

- May/June 2023 Meeting (after GMP is available) Request City Council action on 2 items:
  - To approve CMAR construction contract
    - Proposed 20% MBE/10% WBE
  - To approve sale and issuance of \$30 million Limited Obligation Bonds
    - Reimburse City for previous design work

Debt service included current tax rate

No issuance of 2/3 General Obligation Bonds in October 2022
