**PURPOSE:**

City Council is requested to approve the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the three jurisdictions partnering in the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).

**BACKGROUND:**

The 2022 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funds of \$297,844 will be administered by the Greensboro Police Department. The funding will be divided between the Greensboro Police Department, Guilford County Sheriff's Office, and the High Point Police Department. The allocations for each jurisdiction are:

- Guilford County: \$ 74,814
- City of Greensboro: \$ 168,128
- City of High Point: \$ 54,902

The funding agency, the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, requires a memorandum of understanding (MOU) that identifies which jurisdiction will serve as the applicant or fiscal agent for joint funds must be completed and signed by the authorized representative for each participating jurisdiction. Once an award is made, the fiscal agent will be responsible for distributing award funds to the other jurisdictions in the disparate group through sub-awards that include all appropriate award conditions.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

This is a reimbursable grant and any expenses exceeding the JAG funding will be absorbed by each agency's budget.

**RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:**

It is recommended that City Council adopt the resolution executing the required Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the 2022 Justice Assistance Grant between the three partnering entities.
