PURPOSE:

Janice and Benny Vickers are requesting annexation of the property located at 6001 Burlington Road, generally described as north of Burlington Road and east of Knox Road. As this request is a voluntary annexation petition, the City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider and take action on this request at its September 20, 2022 meeting.

BACKGROUND:

This noncontiguous annexation is within the boundary of Growth Tier 3 on the Anticipated Growth Maps in the Comprehensive Plan. Although the site is located in Growth Tier 3, it has been determined that city services cannot be provided until January 1, 2023

City water will be available by connecting to the 16-inch line located within Burlington Road. In order for this site to be served with water the owner would be responsible for all costs associated with extending and connecting to the public line.

City sewer will be available by connecting to the 8-inch outfall currently under construction to the west of the site. In order for this site to be served with sanitary sewer the owner would be responsible for all costs associated with extending and connecting to the public line.

The City's Fire Department notes that this site is currently served by McLeansville Station #37 located on Knox Road (south of the site). Upon annexation the site will be served by City Station #57 located on Mount Hope Church Road (west of the site). At this time, Greensboro's Standard of Coverage based on current deployable resources cannot be met. When the council-approved contract with Guilford County Fire Station #50 becomes effective (January 1, 2023) Greensboro's Standard of Coverage will then be achieved.

The Police Department can provide comparable response service to the property under consideration as of the date of annexation. Additional resources may be required as development on the subject property and/or additional annexation in the general area occurs.

Field Operations will be able to provide sanitation services to this site.

Provision of other City services will involve a travel distance almost equal to that necessary to provide service to the previously-annexed property located to the south and west.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Initial service will be absorbed in the budget; future services will have an incremental effect on future budgets.

RECOMMENDATION / ACTION REQUESTED:

The Technical Review Committee (TRC) recommended this annexation to the Planning and Zoning Commission and to City Council.

The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of this annexation at its August meeting on a vote of 9-0.

Accordingly, it is recommended that City Council hold a public hearing to receive public comment and to consider adoption of an ordinance annexing the above-mentioned property into the City of Greensboro.
