PURPOSE:

To establish contract between GuilfordWorks and Longleaf Network. Longleaf will provide employment and on the job training services to eligible individuals through GuilfordWorks GEAR UP Adult Specialized program.

BACKGROUND:

Longleaf, also referred to as Employer Partner provides employment and on the job training services to eligible individuals. They provide well-supervised, well-structured, and meaningful training experience to participants. Longleaf program aims increase participants' knowledge of work readiness skills and experience with proper work habits as well as developmental skills. The Longleaf Network Apprenticeship Program training site will be monitored by GuilfordWorks staff and the local area staff.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The agreed contract will be \$112,320.00 annually for a period of (1) year. Funds are available in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Budget.
