PURPOSE:

City Council consideration is requested for a 1,445 linear foot eight-inch sewer line extension from an existing outfall on Little Santee Road to 8923 West Market Street. In accordance with Section 6.140 of the City Charter, City Council shall hold a Public Hearing to consider any property owner objections to the legality of authorizing the assessable sewer line improvement project.

BACKGROUND:

The Guilford County Department of Public Health evaluated the septic system for the property located at 8923 West Market Street and determined it was not properly functioning. Due to the limited lot size, the County determined the most feasible method of correcting this matter, is to recommend a connection to the city's sewer system. A Notice of Public Hearing for Local Improvements was mailed to the last known property owners on October 20, 2022 and advertised on November 3, 2022.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The estimated construction cost of this project is \$350,000. The properties will be assessed at \$16.00 per front foot for the sewer line as allowed by City Charter Section 6.131. The projected recovery through assessments levied against the adjoining properties is approximately \$5,718. Funding for the project is budgeted in the Water Resources Capital Improvements fund.
