PURPOSE:

City Council approval is requested for change order #2 to Contract 2018-065 (EB-5883) for the East/West Wendover Avenue Sidewalk Design. This change order for \$37,279.24 is to provide design changes that were not included in the original contract.

BACKGROUND:

This change order is necessary due to additional design services that are required as the design firm proceeded with their preliminary work. The current contract work consists of design services for narrowing the existing median, shifting travel lanes inward and installing median barrier and guardrail where needed to separate the eastbound and westbound lanes. These changes provide additional room to widen the existing bridge deck sidewalk to have acceptable clearance around existing overhead utility poles. Work will also include design of a barrier to separate the pedestrian sidewalks on both sides of the bridge from the roadway to improve pedestrian safety; and the

additional structural design and plan preparation efforts necessary to evaluate the existing bridge structure and provide details for performing this construction.

This project includes Federal funding and is subject to the U.S. Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program. The M/WBE Program Plan expressly states, "...the following categories of contracts shall be excluded from the scope and application of this Program Plan: (a) Contracts that are subject to the U.S. Department of Transportation Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program and Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program as set forth in 49 CFR Parts 23 and 26 or any successor regulations or legislation."

A contract award in the amount of \$252,904.48 was awarded to AECOM Technical Services of NC on February 11, 2019. Change order #1 increased the total contract award to \$421,920.45. This change order in the amount of \$37,279.24 increases the total contract award to \$459,199.69.

Funds for this change order will come from the Transportation Department's Wendover Avenue Sidewalk account 401-4571-01.5410 in the amount of \$37,279.24.
