

# City of Greensboro Meeting Minutes - DRAFT City Council Work Session

## May 12, 2022, 2:00 p.m. Virtual

### A. <u>Call To Order</u>

This virtual City Council work session of the City of Greensboro was called to order at 2 p.m. on the above date.

Mayor Vaughan took a roll call to confirm Councilmembers in attendance.

### B. <u>Presentations</u>

B.1 Housing GSO Progress Report

Neighborhood Development Director Michelle Kennedy made a PowerPoint Presentation (PPP); spoke to the need for affordable rental units; to the Housing GSO plan goals; to a implementation timeline; to income threshold; to staff capacity; to a demolition list; and to Code Enforcement.

Discussion took place regarding asbestos abatement in rental properties; housing needs; and community reinvestment.

Ms. Kennedy continued the PPP; spoke to permanent housing; and to the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP).

Discussion ensued regarding the application process; biweekly county meetings; multifamily development projects; American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds; landlord incentives; hotel partnerships; food pantries; tourism; and stakeholder process.

Mayor Vaughan requested staff to provide a "mini budget" with the one-cent allocation for affordable housing; and Departmental budget recommendations.

Planning Manager Mike Kirkman made a PPP; outlined the current regulations; spoke to short term rentals, tourist rentals and bed and breakfasts; to development standards; to community engagement; and to public hearings.

Discussion continued regarding noise ordinance violations; after hour complaints; neighborhood safety; distance between homes; and zoning permits.

Councilmember Outling requested staff to research noise ordinance enforcement after business hours.
