### PURPOSE:

The attached ordinance serves to amend the Cemeteries Fund to allow for additional expenses and revenues related to more activities than anticipated during budget adoption. A budget ordinance needs to be approved to fund the additional expenses and revenues.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The FY 21-22 Cemeteries Fund Budget was adopted with expenses and revenues totaling \$952,573. Expenditures through May total \$71,703 and are anticipated to exceed the budgeted amount. Additional appropriations are necessary to allow operations through the end of the year. Projected additional expenses and revenues are due to better than anticipated activity than budgeted for in the FY 21-22 process, including higher revenue from fees at Forest Lawn Cemetery. The budget ordinance will proved the additional appropriations necessary to maintain operations for activities through the end of the year. No additional General Fund support is necessary.
