PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro's M/WBE Office is requesting funding for the Disparity Study contract.

BACKGROUND:

The City's M/WBE Office is responsible for overseeing that the procurement of services adheres to the M/WBE Policy adopted in 2014. Procurement Services issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to establish a contract. On February 21, 2022 an RFP was solicited under Event Number 10564, using the Greensboro e-Procurement System (GePS). The GePS solicitation was sent to 1603 vendors. Additionally, a list of M/WBE subcontractors was provided under the GePS solicitation for the intended proposers to utilize in the performance of this contract. The City received two responsive bid for this service. The recommended proposer has provided an affidavit committing 8% of the work performed to a MBE firm with the State of North Carolina.

A selection committee reviewed the submitted responsive bids. The committee evaluated the bids on responsiveness to the specification criteria, qualifications, timeliness, experience, past performances, and costs. Griffin & Strong, P.C. was selected as the best value.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The total estimated contract award is in an amount of \$300,000.00.
