PURPOSE:

City Council approval is requested to extend Contract 2012-5493 with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC to continue providing service and maintenance to the Police Headquarters generator. The extension is for five years with a value of \$241,920.

BACKGROUND:

The Police Department installed a Duke Energy generator to provide power to the Police Headquarters building in case of power outages when the building opened in 2012. The City signed a ten-year lease with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC to provide service and maintenance to the generator and the contract is set to expire. The Police Department wishes to continue the service and extend the lease agreement for five years. The total value of the five year lease extension is \$241,920.
