PURPOSE:

Water Resources Department is requesting approval for a Change Order to Contract 2022-5024 for additional sewer modeling for the Big Alamance Sewershed Study. City Council approval of a change order in the amount of \$39,000 is requested.

BACKGROUND:

The City Manager approved a contract with Freese and Nichols, Inc. on February 8, 2022 for the execution of Contract 2022-5024, Big Alamance Sewershed Study, in the amount of \$80,475. The Big Alamance Sewershed Study project evaluates sewer capacity in the Big Alamance Lift Station drainage basin. The study included sewer modeling, future flow projections, and evaluation of future scenarios. The additional services requested of Freese and Nichols, Inc. through Change Order #1 includes evaluating additional potential flow scenarios through engineering modeling.

The original Contract with Freese had a WBE utilization of 7.5%. With the total Contract value from this change order for modeling services increasing to \$119,475, the M/WBE utilization for the total contract will drop to 5.02%. Taylor Engineering, a WBE, will be utilized for 5.02% of the committed scope of services.
