**SUBJECT:** 2022 Report of Delinquent Accounts and Request For  
Resolution Ordering Lien Advertisement

Each year City Council adopts a resolution approving and ordering the advertisement of liens for delinquent accounts owed to the City of Greensboro, which by provision of State Statute and Local Regulation are secured by liens upon real property and which result from the following activities:

- (1) Public Utility Services
- (2) Nuisance Abatements
- (3) Boarding Up of Structures
- (4) Demolition of Substandard Structures

The aforementioned liens are authorized pursuant to Section 6.31 and 6.83 of the City Charter and North Carolina General Statute's 160D-1203(7) and 160A-193.

Since these liens have the same legal standing as unpaid Ad Valorem Tax, North Carolina General Statute 105-369 requires a report to the Governing Body listing the current amount of said liens, for which advertisement is required. Such a report is provided below.
