PURPOSE:

Hold a public hearing and consider adoption of the Fleming Road Area Plan and accompanying amendments of the *GSO*2040 Future Land Use Map and Future Built Form Map.

BACKGROUND:

The <u>Fleming Road Area Strategic</u> Plan is intended to guide future decisions regarding properties within the Fleming Road study area, generally between Lewiston Road and Ballinger Road.

The planning and public engagement process included:

- initial research into the history of the area and development along the corridor;
- initial stakeholder interviews;
- three open house meetings attended by over 150 residents and property owners; and
- online surveys and an interactive comment map.

The Plan establishes the following Vision:

The Fleming Road Study Area is distinguished by its quiet character, quality housing, and countryside feel, and is a safe place for all—including pedestrians, bicyclists, and

drivers—with a plan to ensure that any future growth or development is compatible within the context of the Fleming Road Study Area.

The Plan also sets forth a series of Objectives intended to achieve the stated Vision, and which are focused on:

- 1. Maintaining the quiet, safe, and predominantly low-density residential character of the area:
- 2. Improving traffic law compliance and safety for all road users;
- 3. Protecting the natural environment including trees, streams and watersheds, and wildlife and their habitats;
- 4. Improving the quantity and quality of recreational facilities and green spaces; and
- 5. Promoting the use of high quality design, materials, and landscaping in conjunction with future development activity in the area.

The Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing at the regular meeting on March 20 and voted unanimously in support of a motion recommending that City Council adopt the Plan and accompanying amendments of the *GSO*2040 Future Land Use Map and Future Built Form Map.
