#### **PURPOSE:**

As a condition of receiving Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grant funds, the City of Greensboro must submit an Annual Action Plan on behalf of Greensboro and HOME Consortium member jurisdiction, Guilford County. After City Council approval, the Annual Action Plan is due to HUD by May 15, 2023.

#### **BACKGROUND:**
