**PURPOSE:**

As a condition of receiving Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grant funds, the City of Greensboro must submit an Annual Action Plan on behalf of Greensboro and HOME Program Consortium member jurisdiction, Guilford County. After City Council approval, the Annual Action Plan is due to HUD by May 15, 2023.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Annual Action Plan describes how the City and HOME Consortium plan to meet ongoing commitments and mandates using the anticipated FY 2023-2024 awards. CDBG funds will be used for housing rehabilitation, public services, infrastructure, and neighborhood reinvestment.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

\$2,411,572 in new Federal HUD CDBG grant funds and an estimated \$150,000 in program income will be available to address affordable housing and community revitalization needs in Greensboro for a total of \$2,561,572
