### PURPOSE:

The purpose of this contract, which began on 1/1/23 and extends through 12/31/25, is for GCES Rescue 50 to respond with city fire units and other county contracted fire units inside newly annexed areas of east Greensboro, so the fire department can meet response standard of coverage.

### BACKGROUND:

The City of Greensboro maintains a number of contracts with county fire departments for co-response into areas inside the city of Greensboro, with the intent to meet fire department response standard of coverage.

### BUDGET IMPACT:

Council has approved the funding of \$170,000.00 each fiscal year for the length of the contract. No additional funds are required.
