PURPOSE:

A Resolution is required for the Transportation Department to enter into a three-year contract for the installation of thermoplastic pavement markings on City of Greensboro streets.

BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Department is responsible for marking City and NCDOT maintained roadways in the City limits of Greensboro with retro-reflective glass beaded thermoplastic pavement markings. These markings are used to mark traffic lanes, road boundaries and symbols on paved surfaces and are the final touch on roadway projects.

On February 2, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to establish a contract for the installation of thermoplastic pavement markings using the Greensboro e-Procurement System (GePS). The GePS solicitation was sent to 65 vendors. The M/WBE office advised that there were eight potential M/WBE firms that were solicited directly via email. The City received one responsive bid for this service.

A selection committee evaluated the bid on responsiveness to the specification criteria, price, and experience in performing the requested services. The committee also evaluated the vendor's capacity and proof of proper equipment to meet the specification requirements. Triad Road Maintenance Company Inc, a certified WBE firm with the State of North Carolina, was selected as the best value and qualified bidder to provide this service.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funding for this contract is budgeted for the Transportation Department in an estimated annual amount of \$250,000.

It is recommended that City Council approve the contract in the Amount of \$750,000 with Triad Road Maintenance Company Inc, for the installation of thermoplastic pavement markings requested by the Transportation Department.
