#### **PURPOSE**:

To establish an Ordinance for the third round of CDBG-CV funds in the amount of \$1,611,301

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development allocated funds to the City of Greensboro, as authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. The 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan was amended to program and authorize \$1,611,301 in CDBG-CV funding made available by the CARES Act to provide homelessness prevention and supportive housing.

City Council approved and adopted the Fourth Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan at its May 4, 2021 meeting. A Budget Ordinance is needed for this CDBG-CV allocation.
