# Time for Swimming!

- Warnersville and Windsor pools will open from Memorial Day through Labor Day
- Pool hours are extended to 11 am to 7 pm during the week and 11 am to 6 pm on the weekend
- No admission fees will be charged this summer
- Peeler and Lindley pools will remain closed for needed repairs







# Time for Swimming!

- \$1.1 million from American Rescue Plan funding was approved by City Council in August 2022 for needed pool repairs
- Peeler and Warnersville pool repairs are estimated to begin in fall 2023 following completion of construction documents and bidding
- Lindley pool repairs continue with additional structural repairs under redesign





#### **Swim Lessons**

- In partnership with the YMCA of Greensboro, swim lessons will be offered to recreation center day camp participants and the general public
- Safety Around Water classes are a first step in equipping children with essential water safety skills to reduce the risk of drowning and build skills and confidence around the water
- Schedule is being finalized

#### **Process**





#### **Facility Recommendations**

- Renovation of current swimming pool locations totaling \$48,282,734
  - A pool will be featured at each location
  - Added amenities vary by park, based on physical space availability and community interests
- Sprayground upgrades totaling \$1,891,161
- Addition of aquatic facilities totaling \$31,602,749
  - Future park at Short Farm Road full service aquatic facility
  - Griffin Community Park full service aquatic facility
  - Brown Community Park sprayground
  - Hester Park sprayground
- Phasing options are included in plan





# **Next Steps**

- Public review of draft Aquatic Master Plan ended May 3
- Parks and Recreation Commission to consider recommending approval of plan at June 14 meeting
- Consideration for adoption by City Council in summer 2023
- Facility recommendations will be included within Capital Improvement Program as unfunded projects
