PURPOSE:

To appropriate available fund balance and sales tax revenue for Business Improvement District

BACKGROUND:

The City entered into an amended contract with Downtown Greensboro Inc., effective July 1, 2021, for the Business Improvement District Program (BID). Ad Valorem Taxes, Registered Motor Vehicle Taxes and Sales Taxes generated in the BID are used to fund this agreement. At fiscal year-end 2022, the Business Improvement District section of the Special Tax Districts Fund had an available fund balance of \$88,750 that requires an appropriation to disburse to Downtown Greensboro Inc. in the current year. Additional appropriations of \$131,250 are estimated to be adequate to allow for disbursement of the expected remaining sales tax and property tax amounts to be collected in the BID during the rest of the fiscal year.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The Special Tax Districts Fund will appropriate fund balance and sales tax revenues and increase the appropriation in 210-20-2003001.5931, Contributions to Nongovernmental Agencies.
