PURPOSE:

The Downtown Greenway received damage due to a vehicular accident with damages to railing and stairs at Murrow Boulevard and Summit Avenue. In order to receive insurance claim funds a budget amendment is requested from Greensboro City Council in accordance with current city fiscal procedures.

BACKGROUND:

On February 27, 2023 an automobile left the roadway on Summit Avenue and proceeded to roll down an embankment and stairway ultimately landing on the Downtown Greenway at Murrow Boulevard. As a result of the accident multiple sections of decorative fence, handrails and concrete stairs were damaged along with a decorative bench. Given the specific fixtures used on the Downtown Greenway the original contractor, Yates Construction, was consulted concerning the cost of repair. The estimate from Yates Construction was submitted as part of a claim against the driver's insurance company. Due to the ongoing usage of the greenway and need to provide safe pedestrian access from Summit Avenue to the Downtown Greenway at Murrow Boulevard, the repairs in the amount of \$57,045 were deemed necessary.
