#### **PURPOSE**:

A budget ordinance is required to establish the budget for a municipal agreement with NCDOT for EB-6033AI Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure Grant.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Project EB-6033AI provides for the City of Greensboro to receive a grant of federal Safe Routes to School funds over a two year period starting in fall 2023. This grant will support programming for students in grades K-12, including the development of education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation strategies to increase the safety and convenience for students to walk and bicycle to school. This grant succeeds EB-6033F, which began in 2019 and will be complete by October 2023. NCDOT awarded this grant to the City following a statewide funding competition. GDOT applied for the grant with the support of Guilford County Schools, Bicycling in Greensboro Inc., the Guilford County Department of Health, and multiple city departments.

The agreement defines eligible project costs, responsibilities and requirements. The agreement provides for reimbursement of 80% of project costs up to \$274,405. The City will provide 20% matching funds in the amount of \$68,601.

### **BUDGET IMPACT**:

Funding for this project will be as follows:

\$274,405 (80%) Federal Funds \$68,601 (20%) Transportation Bond Funds \$343,006
