PURPOSE:

A resolution needs to be approved to authorize a municipal agreement with NCDOT for EB-6033AI Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure Grant.

BACKGROUND:

Project EB-6033AI provides for the City to receive a grant of federal Safe Routes to School funds. NCDOT awarded this grant to the City following a statewide funding competition. The funds will support development of education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation strategies to increase the safety and convenience for children and youths to walk and/or bicycle to school. This grant covers a two year period and succeeds EB-6033F, which began in 2019 and will be complete by October 2023. This grant will support programming for students in grades K-12, which extends the scope of the prior grant which was focused on K-5 programming. GDOT applied for the grant with the support of Guilford County Schools, Bicycling in Greensboro Inc., the Guilford County Department of Health, and multiple city agencies.

This agreement defines project costs and responsibilities and requirements. The agreement provides for reimbursement of 80% of project costs up to \$274,405. The City will provide 20% matching funds in the amount of \$68,601.
