#### **PURPOSE**:

As a condition of receiving Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grant funds, the City of Greensboro must submit an Annual Action Plan on behalf of Greensboro and HOME Consortium member jurisdiction, Guilford County.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Annual Action Plan describes how the City and HOME Consortium plan to meet ongoing commitments and mandates using the anticipated FY 2023-2024 ESG awards. City Council approved the Annual Action Plan on April 17, 2023.

#### **BUDGET IMPACT:**

\$208,732 in new Federal ESG grant funds will be available to address rapid re-housing for households experiencing housing instability, including housing identification, placement, rental assistance, and case management services.
