PURPOSE:

As a condition of receiving Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grants funds, the City of Greensboro must submit an Annual Action Plan on behalf of Greensboro and HOME Consortium member jurisdiction, Guilford County.

BACKGROUND:

The Annual Action Plan describes how the City and HOME Consortium plan to meet ongoing commitments and mandates using the anticipated FY 2023-2024 awards. The City of Greensboro is the administrative agent for the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME). City Council approved the Annual Action Plan on April 17, 2023.

BUDGET IMPACT:

\$1,673,037 in new federal HUD grant funds and an estimated \$100,000 in program income will be available to address affordable housing needs in Greensboro.
