PURPOSE:

This resolution calls for a public hearing to be set by City Council, to adopt technical corrections to the language of Ordinance 22-202. Ordinance 22-202 was adopted on September 20, 2022, annexing into the corporate limits properties located at: 3911 S. Elm-Eugene Street, 4007 ZZ S. Elm-Eugene Street, 4007 S. Elm-Eugene Street, 4009 S. Elm-Eugene Street, 4011 South Elm-Eugene Street, 4013 South Elm-Eugene Street, 4209 Cahill Drive, 4300 Cahill Drive, 4315 Cahill Drive, 4318 Cahill Drive, and 4324 Cahill Drive.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Sections 160A-31 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the City of Greensboro received annexation petitions from all owners of the above referenced properties and held a duly noticed public hearing on September 20, 2022 to consider these annexation petitions. Following the public hearing, City Council voted 8-0 and passed Ordinance 22-202 to annex the properties.

However, Ordinance 22-202 contained typographical errors in the description of the annexed properties. This resolution calls for a public hearing to discuss the necessary corrections to Ordinance 22-202.
