PURPOSE:

An ordinance is requested to increase the budget for supplemental agreement #9 with the NC Department of Transportation for U-5326 Market/College/Guilford College Intersection Project.

BACKGROUND:

Project U-5326 improved the Market Street-College Road-Guilford College Road intersection with roadway widening, sidewalks, and operational and safety improvements. Construction work is complete, and the City is working to complete final administrative close out of the construction contract. Per City request, NCDOT agreed to provide additional funding to support costs required to settle outstanding invoices and close-out the project. This Agreement specifies the reimbursement amount and the steps the City must following in order to receive the funding.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funding for this project will increase as follows:

\$362,804 State Funds (100%)

No local matching funds are required.
