These individuals are fathers, mothers, sons, daughters, aunts, uncles, friends and more, and the National Homeless Persons' Memorial Day has been established to honor those who lost their lives during the calendar year. On December 21, people from across the country will come together to pay their respects, and shine a light on the epidemic of homelessness.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In 1990, the National Coalition for the Homeless and the National Health Care for the Homeless Council commemorated December 21 - the longest night of the year - as the first Homeless Persons' Memorial Day to remember those who died during the year without housing.
