PURPOSE:

Request public hearing be held to consider Landmark designation for the Bradshaw-Freeman House, 603 N. Church Street.

BACKGROUND:

The City received a recommendation from the Guilford County Historic Preservation Commission to designate the Bradshaw-Freeman House, 603 N. Church Street a Guilford County Historic Landmark. The proposed designation includes the entire exterior and the entire interior and the grounds of the house. The Bradshaw-Freeman House is important because it is a fine example of Frank Lloyd Wright's Prairie School with an intact Arts and Crafts interior.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Landmark designation makes the owner eligible for a deferral of up to 50% of City and County property taxes. The total appraised value of the property is \$376,200. The tax deferral is calculated by the Guilford County Tax Department based on the percentage of the property that is designated.
