**PURPOSE:**

A resolution needs to be approved to authorize a municipal agreement in the amount of \$2,537,750 with NC Department of Transportation for BL-0117 A&Y Greenway Bridge Replacement Project.

**BACKGROUND:**

Project HL-0117 will design and construct a replacement bridge and related improvements for the A&Y Greenway over Lake Brandt near Bur-Mil Park. The existing railroad trestle bridge has been closed due to structural deficiencies and related safety concerns identified in a recent structural engineering assessment. Project BL-0117 is intended to design and construct the replacement bridge as soon as possible with an expedited project development process.

Federal funding to cover 80% of eligible project design and construction costs has been secured by the MPO Transportation Advisory Committee and the NCDOT. This agreement specifies the amounts and the steps the City must follow to receive the funding. Under this agreement, NCDOT will reimburse the City \$2,030,200.

**BUDGET IMPACT:**

Funding for this agreement is as follows:

\$2,030,200 Federal Grant (80%)  
\$ 507,550 Local Matching Funds (20%)  
\$2,537,750

**ACCOUNT NUMBER:**

Funding for the local match will come from 2016 Transportation Bond Fund account 481-45-4599139 (\$22,000) and 2022 Transportation Bond Fund account 492-45-4599162 (\$485,550).
