PURPOSE:

Water Resources Department is requesting approval for a contract with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for Utility Relocations as part of P-5709 Burlington Road from East Market Street to Franklin Boulevard the Norfolk Southern Railroad H Line Project.

BACKGROUND:

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has prepared and adopted plans to make street and railroad improvements under Project P-5709 in Guilford County. The project will include the construction of grade separation at Franklin Boulevard railroad crossing in Greensboro, and close O'Ferrell Street railroad crossing. City Council approval of a Contract is requested to support construction activities related to maintaining a reliable and consistent water service for our customers. NCDOT is responsible for the street, grade, and railroad work while the City is responsible for the utility construction betterments and relocations of the water line infrastructure located within the public right of way.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

This project has a MWBE waiver for design and construction of the railroad improvements by the North Carolina Department of Transportation at Franklin Blvd. This project is subject to NCDOT's MWBE/DBE program.
