PURPOSE:

City Council approval is requested for the Water Resources Department to submit an application for the United States Department of Homeland Security's FMA grant program.

BACKGROUND:

The Flood Mitigation Assistance program provides funding opportunities to reduce or eliminate the risk of repetitive flood damage to buildings and structures insured under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The Water Resources Department is requesting permission to apply for the FMA grant program. This application will include property acquisition projects that meet the FMA programs criteria. The program helps jurisdictions to lower the total number of repetitive loss properties within the city limits. The acquisition of NFIP repetitive loss properties supports the city's activities within the Community Rating System (CRS) incentive program and the citizens of Greensboro.
