PURPOSE:

The Parks & Recreation Department was given the opportunity to apply for the 2023-24 Senior Center General Purpose Grant in the amount of \$3,719 to support upgrades at the Trotter Active Adult Center and to advertise programs held at the center. The grant requires a local match of \$1,238 for a total grant project budget of \$4,957. The current City grants policy requires Council approval for grants requiring match funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Piedmont Triad Regional Council Area Agency on Aging offers an annual grant opportunity that the Parks and Recreation Department plans to use to support improvements to the Trotter Active Adult Center located at 3906 Betula Street. The funds will be used for purchasing new activity tables and padded chairs, and an advertisement in the Triad Relocation Guide about programs offered at the center.

The project provides health and wellness opportunities to City residents ages 50 and up and supports the Department's goals, strategies and objectives: to seek and partner with outside organizations to maximize human and financial resources and maintain viability through partnerships, grants, and volunteer efforts.

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

BUDGET IMPACT:

The total grant project budget of \$4,957 would include the grant award of \$3,719 and local fund match in the amount of \$1,238. Funding for the local match is available in the current Active Adults budget. If the grant is approved and awarded, City funds will leverage \$3.00 in grant funds for every City dollar invested in the project. A budget adjustment and ordinance is required to establish the grant account for this project
