PURPOSE:

The City of Greensboro Water Resources Department is requesting approval to accept State Grant funding from the NC Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) Division of Water Infrastructure for a \$375,000 grant to aid in the design of the Fairview Street SCM Retrofit. The department is also requesting authority for the Director of Water Resources to execute documents on behalf of the City of Greensboro for this agreement.

BACKGROUND:

The City received an Offer and Acceptance letter for American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding in the amount of \$375,000 for the Fairview Street SCM Retrofit Design. The Fairview Street project consists of rehabilitation of an existing stormwater pond dam and the retrofit of the pond into a future SCM. The City has executed design contracts for the dam rehabilitation work and SCM retrofit. It is anticipated that \$184,708 of design expenses will be reimbursed to the City through the grant. The City will continue to work with NCDEQ on reimbursable expenses for the remaining \$190,292 of the \$375,000 with the expectation of utilizing the full grant amount.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Vision Statement: "A Community with Endless Economic Opportunities and Exceptional Quality of Life."

This grant funding will increase the Water Resources Grant Fund budget by \$375,000. The remainder of funds for design have been allocated through the Stormwater Capital Fund.

It is recommended that City Council approve the acceptance of State grant funding from the NC Department of Environmental Quality State Fiscal Recovery Funds in the amount of \$375,000 with the Division of Water Infrastructure, and authorize the Director of Water Resources to execute documents as required to carry out this agreement.
