### **PURPOSE**:

The City of Greensboro received a grant from Colonial Pipeline in the amount of \$8,000 for training of the Fire Department Foam Task Force Team. A budget amendment needs to be approved by the City Council to permit the expenditure of funds.

### **BACKGROUND:**

This training grant from Colonial Pipeline provides funding for Greensboro Fire Department to protect one of the largest refined fuel storage facilities in the United States. With funds, Greensboro Fire Department personnel will attend Williams Extreme Industrial Fire and Hazard training. Greensboro Fire Department has a large investment of personnel and equipment for the Foam Task Force and this training grant supports the goals of the program. The training grant allows the GFD to enhance its response capabilities in terms of resources that benefit the citizens and businesses of Greensboro as well as the State of North Carolina.
